NSW Ports manages two of Australia's premier trade gateways, Port Botany and Port Kembla, and two major intermodal terminals.

Sydney's network of intermodals is connected by a dedicated freight rail line to Port Botany—Australia's only container port with on-dock rail at each terminal.

Port Botany moves the most number of containers to and from the port by rail in Australia and NSW Ports is continuing to invest to substantially grow this volume into the future, delivering:

- Faster turn-around times
- Cheaper transport costs for importers and exporters
- Reduced CO<sub>2</sub> emissions
- Fewer truck movements

In collaboration with Patrick Terminals, the Sydney AutoStrad Botany Rail Terminal (SABRE) was recently opened, delivering more than \$190 million in investment in rail infrastructure at Port Botany.
