## Supply Chain Community Award

### Award Overview

The Supply Chain Community Award recognises organisations making a positive social impact beyond commercial consideration. It celebrates leadership in community partnership, education and social investment that strengthens communities in Australia.

### Eligibility

- Companies operating within Australia's supply chain industry including for example air, sea, road, rail, ports, warehousing, infrastructure, technology, manufacturing or other supply chain services.
- Applicants must demonstrate a community-focused initiative delivered within the past three years, including (but not limited to) global diversity, education, community partnership or engagement, social equity, regional or local community investment.

### Judging Criteria

Judges will assess nominations against the following criteria:

#### 1. Community Focus and Values Alignment

- Clear identification of community need
- Strong rationale and purpose for the initiative
- Alignment with organisational values and leadership commitment

#### 2. Partnership & Implementation

- Quality and depth of community or stakeholder partnership
- Evidence of collaboration and shared value creation
- Effective delivery and governance

#### 3. Measurable Community Impact

- Clear evidence of positive social or community outcomes
- Use of data, participation metrics and qualitative evidence is also encouraged.

#### 4. Sustainability, Scalability & Legacy

- Ability to scale or replicate across communities or regions
- Actual or planned enduring benefit for community
- Demonstrated leadership and positive industry influence.
