Supply Chain Industry & Government Partnership Award

Award Overview

The Supply Chain Partnership Award recognises successful collaboration between government and business that has delivered meaningful supply chain reform. It celebrates projects or programs that improve productivity, resilience or sustainability through policy alignment, infrastructure investment or operational innovation at a local, state or national scale.

Eligibility

- Public and private sector organisations operating within Australia’s supply chain industry including for example air, sea, road, rail, ports, warehousing, infrastructure, technology, manufacturing or other supply chain services.
- A government–business partnership involving a supply chain company and a government department or agency (local, state or Commonwealth).
- The initiative must demonstrate tangible improvement in supply chain productivity, resilience and/or sustainability. Outcomes must extend beyond business-as-usual engagement.
- Applications must include delivery milestones and credible evidence of impact.
- Applications will only be accepted from companies and government departments and agencies.

Judging Criteria

1. Partnership Design & Strategic Alignment

- Clarity of shared objectives and reform intent
- Strength of collaboration between government and industry
- Alignment with policy priorities, strategies or reform agendas

2. Collaboration & Implementation Effectiveness

- Quality of engagement, governance and decision-making
- Effectiveness of partnership delivery and coordination
- Demonstrates trust, accountability and shared ownership

3. Measurable Reform Outcomes

- Evidence of meaningful reform outcomes achieved within the past three years
- Demonstrated improvements in supply chain productivity, resilience and/or sustainability
- Clear link between the partnership and outcomes delivered

4. Scalability & Impact

- Ability to scale up or replicate the partnership value

- Broader benefits across the supply chain or jurisdiction
- Actual or potential long-term value and contribution
