

ALC Supply Chain & Logistics Business Awards 2026

Supply Chain Environmental Sustainability Excellence Award

Award Overview

This award recognises organisations leading the transition to more sustainable supply chains. It celebrates excellent initiatives delivering real progress toward supply chain sustainability in Australia.

Eligibility

- Companies operating within Australia's supply chain industry including for example air, sea, road, rail, ports, warehousing, infrastructure, technology, retail, manufacturing or supply chain services.
- Must be able to demonstrate a clear environmental sustainability focus, such as emissions reduction, energy efficiency, waste reduction, circular economy practices, sustainable transport or supply chain decarbonisation.
- Applicants must be able to provide evidence of measurable environmental outcomes.
- The initiative must have been implemented or significantly progressed within the past three years.

Judging Criteria

Judges will assess nominations against the following criteria:

1. Leadership Commitment and Strategic Intent

- Senior leadership commitment to sustainability
- Clear strategic intent and priorities of the initiative or the company
- Alignment with comprehensive organisational sustainability objectives

2. Design & Implementation

- Demonstrated impact beyond compliance or business-as-usual activity
- Effectiveness of the design and delivery
- Evidence of investment and governance
- Integration within the organisation or along the supply chain

3. Measurable Environmental Impact

- Evidence of measurable environmental outcomes achieved.
- Use of data, metrics (e.g. emissions, energy, waste, resource efficiency)
- Clear link between the initiative and sustainability outcomes

4. Contribution to Modern Supply Chain for Australia

- Degree of innovation and/or commitment
- Potential to scale or replicate across the organisation or along the supply chain

- Broader contribution to supply chain sustainability and industry leadership
- Long-term value and resilience.
