

ALC Supply Chain & Logistics Business Awards 2026

Supply Chain Workforce Diversity Award

Award Overview

This award recognises organisations building a stronger, more inclusive supply chain workforce. It celebrates high-impact programs that improve diversity and deliver measurable workforce capability programs involving for example Indigenous and multicultural employment and gender equity.

Eligibility

- Companies operating within Australia's supply chain industry including for example air, sea, road, rail, ports, warehousing, infrastructure, technology, manufacturing or other supply chain services.
- Able to demonstrate a workforce or inclusion program that was implemented in the last three years that has a focus on diversity and workforce capabilities including but not limited to:
 - Indigenous employment and engagement
 - Multicultural workforce participation
 - Gender equity and women's participation
 - Skills development, training or career pathways
 - Inclusive recruitment, retention or progression practices

Judging Criteria

Judges will assess nominations against the following criteria:

1. Workforce Challenge & Strategic Intent

- Clear identification of workforce or inclusion challenges
- Strong rationale and objectives for the program
- Alignment with organisational strategy and leadership commitment

2. Program Design & Implementation

- Quality and effectiveness of program design
- Evidence of investment, resourcing and governance
- Effective implementation and engagement with participants
- Demonstrates impact beyond compliance or one-off activity

3. Measurable Workforce & Inclusion Impact

- Evidence of measurable outcomes achieved within the past three years
- Demonstrated improvements in workforce participation, capability or diversity
- Use of data, metrics or credible qualitative evidence
- Outcomes are sustained or repeatable

4. Sustainability, Scalability & Industry Impact

- Long-term commitment to workforce inclusion and capability
- Ability to scale or replicate across the organisation or sector.
- Broader contribution to industry workforce development
- Demonstrates leadership and lasting impact.
