Supply Chain Safety & Wellbeing Award

Award Overview

The Supply Chain Safety & Wellbeing Award recognises organisations with an outstanding commitment to improving safety, health and wellbeing outcomes across the organisation and/or across the broader supply chain industry. The award celebrates practical initiatives, leadership and culture-driven approaches that go beyond compliance and deliver positive, measurable outcomes for workers, workplaces and communities.

Eligibility

- Organisations operating within Australia's supply chain industry including for example air, sea, road, rail, ports, warehousing, infrastructure, technology, retail, manufacturing or supply chain services.
- A whole of organisation safety and wellbeing strategy or a specific initiative.
- Demonstrates an innovative commitment to safety and wellbeing beyond minimum regulatory requirements and business as usual.

Judging Criteria

1. Leadership & Safety Culture

- Clear leadership commitment to safety, health and wellbeing at all levels of the organisation
- Safety and wellbeing embedded within organisational values, strategy and decision-making
- Demonstrates a strong, positive and inclusive safety culture

2. Design & Implementation

- Evidence of practical, well-designed safety and/or wellbeing initiatives
- Initiatives go beyond compliance and address real workplace risks or wellbeing challenges
- Effective implementation and engagement across the workforce

3. Measurable Outcomes & Continuous Improvement

- Demonstrated improvements in safety, health and/or wellbeing outcomes
- Use of credible evidence to measure impact and inform continuous improvement
- Evidence of sustained commitment and learning over time

4. Broader Impact & Industry Contribution

- Contribution to improving safety and wellbeing outcomes beyond the organisation
- Collaboration, knowledge sharing or leadership across the supply chain industry
- Potential for initiatives or approaches to be scaled or replicated across the industry
